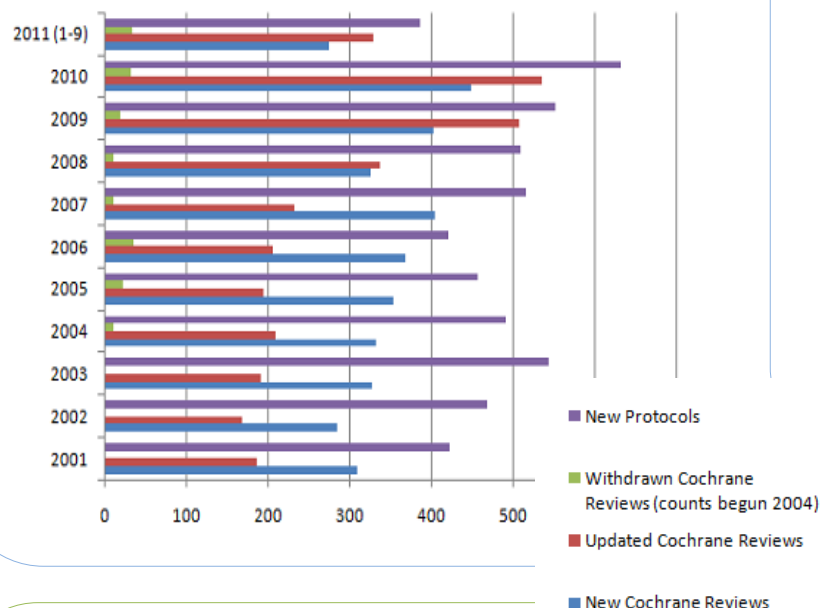
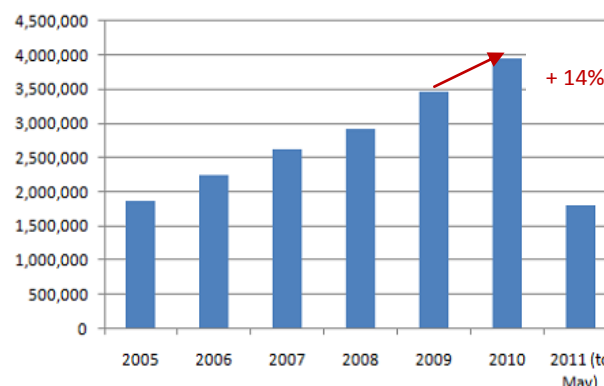

Impact Factor (IF) in ISI in Medicine, General and Internal Category

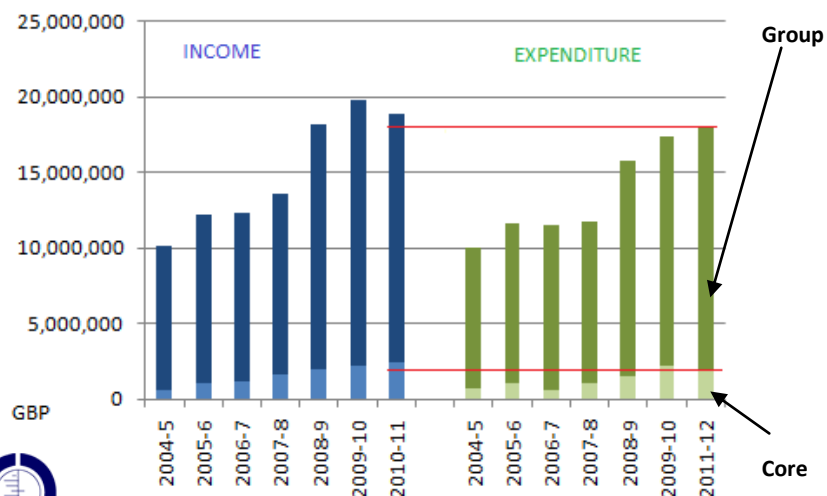
