

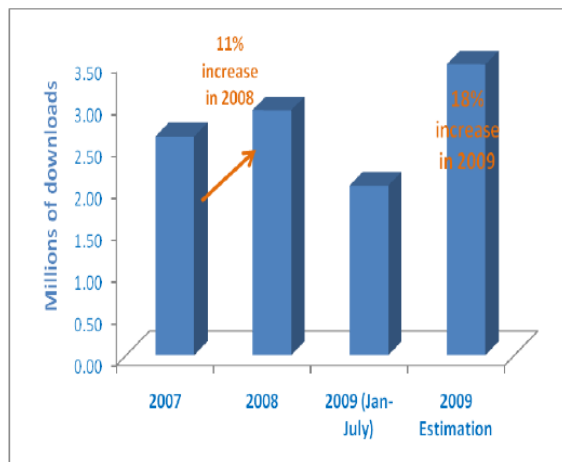

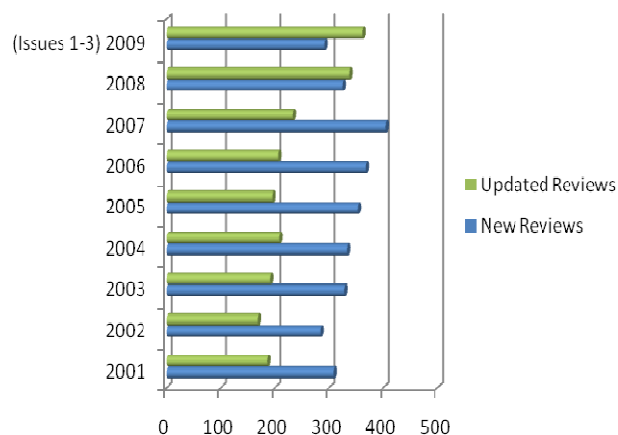

Review usage: Full Text Downloads on Wiley InterScience



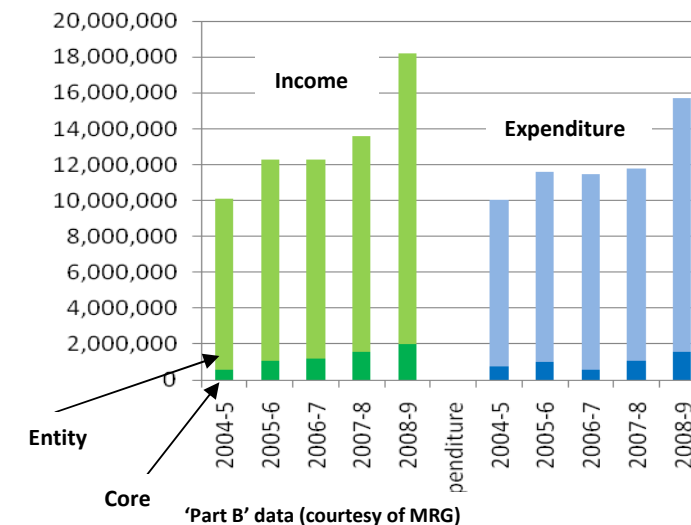

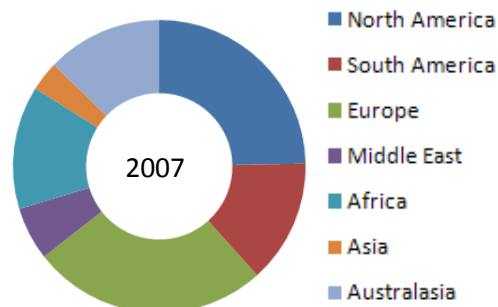

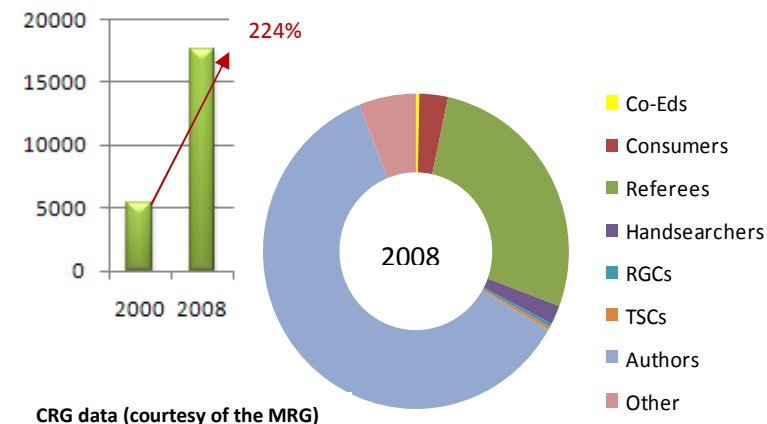
